Birds and Breakfast event

Join the 'Early Birds' on Monday 5th May at 6am for an early bird watch walk around Hopesay near Craven Arms led by ornithologist John Tucker.

There is even a cooked breakfast available afterwards at the Kangaroo Inn at Aston on Clun for those who are hungry! The walk itself, which is part of the Heritage Lottery Funded Churchyard Task Team Project, is free of charge. The cooked breakfast costs £6.00

Meeting at the lovely churchyard in the middle of Hopesay the walk will take people around the old churchyard and village, stopping to look, listen and learn about birds and their song with identification tips from John. Old churchyards are particularly good for birds and Hopesay is no exception.

The walk starts at 6am, which although past the actual time of dawn will still catch a chorus of birds in full song announcing their breeding territories.

Hopesay valley, Hopesay hill and Burrow Camp hill fort are spectacular in spring with an abundance of primroses and other wayside flowers and blossom. So 'step into spring' and join the early morning walk through this beautiful piece of South Shropshire countryside.
